


Adam to Abraham = 2,008 Years + Abraham to "Until Messiah the Prince" = 2,000 Years + Messiah the Prince until the Second Coming of Messiah is equal to 1,992 Years (Note: 1,558 Years (from Adam to Shem's birth) + 2,450 Years = 4,008 Years or from Adam to Messiah the Prince + 1,992 Years (33 A.D./Messiah the Prince until 2025 A.D.) = 6,000 Years or Six Days + 1,000 Years = Seven Days). Genesis 6:3: "My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, for he is indeed flesh, yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years." The "120 Years" are as Jubilee Cycles (i.e., 49 Years + 1 Year = 50 Years = 1 Jubilee Cycle)...120 Jubilee Cycles * 50 Years = 6,000 Years ... there are 40 Jubilee Cycles per each 2,000 years (Adam to Abraham (2,000 years) + Abraham to Messiah the Prince (2,000 years) + Messiah the Prince to the Second Coming of Messiah (2,000 years) - the "8 Years at the end of the 2,008 years of Abraham are purposefully placed at the final 8 years of biblical history to account for the Seventieth Week of Daniel's prophecy, which, likewise, mirrors the 8 days/1 Week of Messiah's Passion Week which was from Nissan 10 to Nissan 17 or Sunday to Sunday over 8 days but each Sunday was but one-half of a day, therefore, although the Passion Week or Holy Week was over an eight-day time frame it must be seen as 3.5 days + 3.5 days = 7 days.



The Tribnet finds the chronologies done here, in the main, excellent - please note the 1558 years to Shem's birth and the 2,048 years to the birth of Isaac. Also, note the 502 years of age of Noah at the birth of Shem and not the 500 years of age - again, the issue of the "Arphaxad Factor" and the two years - here we see a slight extension, therefore, that Shem appears to be 98 years of age and begat Arphaxad when he was 100 years of age; however, we affirm that Shem was 100 years of age at the time of the flood and that he lived 500 years after the flood - therefore, the two-year "Arphaxad Factor" persists - note the 1948 years of Abraham's birth and Terah's 70 years and not 130 years of age - therefore the 60-year "Terah Factor".
